

TOWN OF HARRISON BUILDING PERMIT ATTACHMENT NOTICE

OPEN BURNING PROHIBITED – No person, firm or corporation shall build any outdoor fire within the Town of Harrison boundaries except as set forth in Ordinance 43. This prohibition on burning includes but is not limited to, burning of construction waste and debris at construction sites or demolition of any structures. Some exemptions are allowed.

CONTRACTOR REQUIREMENTS

NO DISCHARGE OF SUMP PUMPS IN ROAD RIGHT OF WAY. Sump pumps shall be discharged to rear of all lots when storm service laterals are not provided. In the event that conditions are not conducive to rear lot drainage, and a mainline Storm sewer system and service laterals within street right-of-way is not provided a secondary sewer collection system shall be provided and shall have a minimum 8" diameter. The storm sewer shall be designed for a 5year storm. No roof drains may be connected to storm sewer system. (Ordinance 80)

ALL EQUIPMENT SHALL ENTER AND EXIT the building site on the graveled pad (driveway). There will be no driving through the open ditches and or curb/gutter at any time. It will be the responsibility of the contractor to be sure all traffic in and out of the building site is over the graveled pad. The Town Board has set a fine of \$1500.00 for anyone who violates this provision of Ordinance #34. The Town Board or its designee shall enforce this state mandated requirement by citation, injunction or other provisional remedy including withholding the occupancy permit and/or issuing a stop work order until compliance is met.

EROSION CONTROL – Erosion control measures shall be installed and maintained throughout the construction of the structure(s), including landscaping. The Town Board or its designee shall enforce this state mandated requirement by citation, injunction or other provisional remedy including withholding the occupancy permit and/or issuing a stop work order until compliance is met. (Ordinance 48)

STREET CLEAN UP – It is the responsibility of the general contractor to ensure that the streets within the Town of Harrison are cleared daily of mud and debris left behind by trucks coming to and going from your construction site. (Ordinance 83)

DITCH/DRAINAGE AREAS - It is the responsibility of the general contractor to ensure that ditch and drainage areas remain free of debris through the completion of construction. Concrete trucks shall not rinse and/or empty and "left over" mix in the road right-of-way(s).

UNLOADING/LOADING OF TRACKED EXCAVATORS – No tracked excavators and/or heavy equipment are allowed to be unloaded/loaded on the black top roads within the Town of Harrison. All activity to take place is on the construction site. Damage costs for repair will be billed to the general contractor.

CONCRETE DRIVEWAYS – Ordinance 32 – No person shall make any excavation or fill, or install any culverts or make any alterations in any town road right of way, or shall not install any concrete driveway, or culvert abutments without the express permission of the Town Board. Any such installation shall be in accordance with the Town road standards.

Due to the fact that the above listed items pose a potential liability hazard, violators will be brought before the Town Board of Harrison. Possible legal action may occur.
